Speed Humps – Pine Tree Road

Council would like to advise residents of its intention to install **speed humps** in the Pine Tree Road area in the near future and to remove the solar speed signs that are currently in place.

A speed hump is a traffic calming device used to reduce vehicle speed on residential streets. While similar to speed bumps, humps are less aggressive than speed bumps at low speeds.

Council has temporarily installed solar speed radar signs in the area and has been monitoring traffic patterns with the following results thus far:

September 22/16	October 13/16
Average speed = 43	Average speed = 40
As of October 14, 2016, an average of 70% of drivers were in violation of the speed limit in this area	
There have been speeds recorded in excess of 70 km/hr	

The safety of all residents is of utmost importance to Council. Your full cooperation is requested in this regard by reducing speed in this area.
